

Camp Erin® LA Volunteer Eligibility Checklist

- I am age 21 or over.
- I do not have any family members attending Camp Erin LA as a camper during the 2019 camp season.
- I am not grieving a recent death. *If you have experienced a significant death within the past 12 months, please contact the Clinical Coordinator of Camp prior to applying.*
- I understand that space is limited and applications are reviewed on a first come, first serve basis. I understand that I cannot be guaranteed a spot in either/both 2019 camp sessions, due to the high volume of applicants.
- I understand that **acceptance to camp is contingent upon:**
 1. Completion of an in-person Volunteer Group Interview
(NEW Volunteers ONLY)
The interview helps us assess each candidate's soft and hard skills in meeting the specific needs of grieving children/teens.
 2. Passing a criminal background check (Live Scan fingerprinting)
(NEW Volunteers ONLY)
 3. My attendance at ALL the REQUIRED dates listed on page 1 of the Volunteer Application
(ALL Volunteers)
- I understand it takes 2-3 weeks from the date I submit my application before I will be contacted.
