

Camper Eligibility Checklist:

- Prospective Camper is age 6-17 (Not graduated high school)
- Prospective Camper experienced the death of someone significant/close to them
 - ➔ The death occurred within the last 4 years AND no less than 3 months before the start of camp.
- Prospective Camper can recall memories of time and/or activities, they spent with their person who died and be willing and able to vocalize and share these memories.
- A parent/guardian of the camper is willing and able to participate in their own session during the camp day and remain present at the campsite for the duration of the camp experience.

Process:

- Completion of a Camp Erin Application found on our website
- A review of prospective Camper's application by our Clinical Team
 - Applications are reviewed on a first come first serve basis
- A phone screening by our Clinical Team
 - It may take up to 3 weeks before a phone screening
- A Camper Pre-camp appointment
 - ➔ The family must attend the pre-camp appointment in our West LA or WH office prior to acceptance to camp

There are some exceptions for zoom appointments on a case-by-case basis, but they must be in the state of California to conduct the appointment.

- ➔ **Acceptance to camp is contingent upon completion of the Camper & Family Pre-Camp appointment**
